- Location: **Alexander Elementary Parking Lot** - the inlet by the dumpsters
- Eligibility: **Open to GL residents only - proof of residence required** (please bring a drivers' license with your GL address, a GL MUD bill, or other proof of residence)
- Logistics: **Drive up**, pop your trunk, and let us unload your stuff (RAE car rider style) **OR park** and bring your recyclables or donations to us

Accepted Recycle Items -- noon - 4pm

✓ **All 'accepted' materials on the list below from CompuCycle.** CompuCycle will be onsite from noon - 4pm and accepts nearly all electronics of any age, working or non-working:

- ✓ Computer Displays (LCD, LED, Plasma), CRT Monitors
- ✓ Laptops and Desktop Computers, Servers
- ✓ Hubs, Routers, Modems & Switches
- ✓ Hard Drives, Memory Chips / RAM, Processor Chips
- ✓ Keyboards & Mice, Cables & Cords
- ✓ Printers, Fax Machines
- ✓ Circuit Boards/ Electronic Components
- ✓ Cell Phones, PDA's, Telephones
- ✓ UPS/ Battery Backup, Power Supplies
- ✓ Toner Cartridges (new and used)
- ✓ Televisions (CRT TVs up to 36" Only), Televisions (LCD, Plasma & LED)
- ✓ Cable TV Boxes
- ✓ DVD/CD/VCR Players
- ✓ Game devices (Xbox, Play Station, Nintendo, etc.)

Accepted Donation Items (NEW this year!) -- 1pm - 2:30pm only

✓ **'Accepted' items listed below from Katy Christian Ministries KCM** will be onsite from 1pm -2:30pm only and "can accept furniture, appliances, electronics, housewares and clothing in good, working condition with no stains, tears or soiling. KCM reserves the right to respectfully refuse donations that we believe we would be unable to sell. This is to prevent us from incurring additional costs associated with recycling/disposing of the items." All items must be boxed or bagged. Items NOT Accepted

KCM Cannot Accept:

- Items that are damaged, dirty, wet, have excessive pet hair, are incomplete, worn-out or not working.
- We also cannot accept CRT computer monitors, tube TVs, console TVs/Stereos, large office desks – cubicles, disassembled particle board furniture, large entertainment centers, mattresses or box springs, futons, sleeper sofas, stuffed animals, incomplete games/puzzles, frameless mirrors/glass, toxic chemicals, materials or paint, oversized desks (over 4ft), non-working electronics, recalled cribs (with metal drops) or car seats

Recycling Items Not Accepted:

- Household Appliances: Refrigerators, Stoves, Washer/Dryer, Microwaves, Freezers, Irons, Air Conditioners, Rice Cookers, Space Heaters, Floor Lamps, Fans, Radios, Stereos
- Vacuum Cleaners, Dehumidifiers, Light Bulbs, Oil Waste, Hazardous Materials, Speakers, Media DLT Tapes, Cassette Tapes, CDs, VHS Tapes, Thumb Drives
- Thermostats, Smoke Alarms, Paint, Medical/ Biohazard Waste, Solar Panels
- Batteries: Alkaline AA, AAA, C, D, 9V, Hearing Aids, Watches
